Who is Eligible for this Scholarship?

This award is open to students enrolled in undergraduate or graduate Civil Engineering programs in an accredited Canadian University.

The following criteria must be met by the applicant:

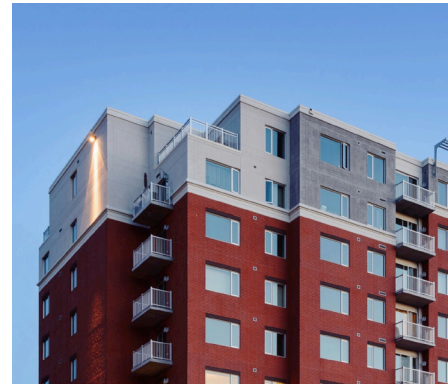
- Applicants attending undergraduate studies must be in their fourth year at the time of application with the intention to pursue graduate studies in the precast-related research field.
- For applicants attending graduate studies, the research topic must be related to precast concrete.
- International students may apply as long as they are enrolled in an accredited Canadian University at the time of application and meeting all other criteria noted.
- Must be a full-time student during the entire scholarship year.
